On August 11, 1959, Governor Tawes opened up for the first ever Governor's Conference on Fire Prevention. Governor Tawes, a member of the Maryland State Firemen's Association, saw the importance of educating the fire service in fire protection and fire prevention. While some topics and members have changed over the years, the goal of our committee has not.

Our mission is to provide top of the line training to our first responders in fire prevention, code enforcement, fire investigations, emergency medical care, emergency management and more, in order to ensure our fire and emergency services stay relevant with new and upcoming technologies, ideas and products and to make sure we make current practices stronger.

For the conference's 65th anniversary, the committee has announced a change in format. The goal is to ensure we can provide this successful training to more attendees and reach further distance across the Mid-Atlantic. This year will consist of 2-days at the BWI Airport Marriott Hotel, in Linthcum Heights, Maryland. This year our schedule will provide for over double the workshops and also new, will be an evening awards banguet and dinner. MALSC









Governor J. Millard Tawes, a past president of the Maryland State Fireman's Association, identified a need to provide fire prevention education to the fire service. In 1959, the first Governor's Conference on Fire Prevention was held at the University of Maryland. While the name has changed over the last 65 years, the mission has not. When the Maryland State Fire Commission was established, it was mandated to host an annual training on fire prevention. In the early 1990s, the Commission delegated what is now known as the Mid-Atlantic Life Safety Conference (MALSC) to the Fire and Burn Safety Coalition of Maryland (FABSCOM). Today the MALSC continues to be a committee of FABSCOM and is represented by over 20 members and partners of the Fire Service. For the last several years, the conference has been held at the Johns Hopkins Applied Physics Lab. In 2023, it was decided that the conference had outgrown the space. To mark the 65th anniversary of the MALSC, the committee has decided to relocate the conference and extend it from a one-day event to a two-day event, in hopes of attracting more attendees from the Mid-Atlantic region. The MALSC is also home to the John C. Spiker, Sr. Excellence in Life Safety Educator of the Year Award and the new Fire Chief James E. Jarboe Public Safety Lifetime Achievement Award, both of which will be announced at the first-ever dinner and banquet.
